WHAT DOES CBG STAND FOR?

The “G” in CBG stands for Cannabigerol, which is the parent cannabinoid in hemp that metabolizes into other cannabinoids like CBD.

WHICH DO I TAKE — CBD OR CBG?

You should take UltraCBG at the same time as CBD for optimal benefits.

DOES IT CONTAIN THC?

UltraCBG conforms to the federal regulations regarding THC at less than 0.3%. Because CBG is the parent compound for both CBD and THC, there will always be trace elements of both before it metabolizes.

IS IT A PART OF THE MIMETIX LINE?

UltraCBG is not a Mimetix™ booster. However, it is acceptable to keep taking UltraBoosters with UltraCBG and UltraCell.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

UltraCBG is designed to help promote healthy digestive and circulatory systems. It has been formulated to be taken with any CBD oil to enhance the entourage effect. CBG is the missing key; it targets the areas CBD can't reach.

WHAT DOES 60 TIMES MORE CBG THAN ULTRACELL MEAN?

Because UltraCell is full spectrum hemp oil, there is a small percentage of CBG incorporated. UltraCBG is also full spectrum but contains 60 times more CBG than UltraCell does because the hemp used is scientifically bred for high CBG content.

HOW MUCH WILL CBG RETAIL FOR?

UltraCBG will retail to match UltraCell for \$149.95 with an MSP of \$119.95.
